## Partial Amendment No.1 to SR-NASDAQ-2014-041

The NASDAQ Stock Market LLC ("NASDAQ") is filing this Partial Amendment No. 1 to SR-NASDAQ-2014-041 to make the following changes to the pending 19b-4 and Exhibit 1:

- 1. In the first line on top of page 10 of 56 and in the fourth sentence of the second paragraph on page 23 of 56 of the 19b-4, as well as in the third line on page 35 of 56 and in the fourth sentence of the full paragraph on page 51 of 56 of the Exhibit 1, replace "intends to" with "will".
- 2. In the second sentence of the last paragraph on page 14 of 56 that carries over to page 15 of 56 of the 19b-4 and in the second sentence of the first paragraph on page 41 of page 56 that carries over to page 42 of 56 of the Exhibit 1, replace at the end of the sentence "a broker quote" with "broker quotes generally provided by brokers that make or participate in markets in the security".
- 3. In the same paragraphs mentioned immediately above, in the fourth and fifth sentences replace "the broker quote" with "broker quotes" and in the sixth sentence replace "the available broker quote is" with "available broker quotes are".

The proposal SR-NASDAQ-2014-041, as amended, remains consistent with the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and specifically with Section 6(b)(5) because it makes technical and clarifying changes to the filing and does not make any changes that are unique or novel. Partial Amendment 1 specifically clarifies that the Fund will limit its investments in asset-backed securities and non-agency mortgage-backed securities (in the aggregate) to 20% of its net assets. Additionally, it clarifies that broker quotes used in pricing an asset-backed or mortgage-backed security will generally be provided by brokers that make or participate in markets in the security.
